Dear Parents/Carers of Year 10 Students

During Year 10 a number of important decisions will be made regarding possible pathways for future education and training for your daughter.

For a number of years at Bethlehem College, Mr Robert Allwell and Associates Educational Psychologists, have been conducting Educational Achievement and Aptitude testing which is linked with the Careers Exploration Program. This consists of three stages:

1. Assessment of educational abilities and skills.

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What am I really good at and what am I interested in?

2. A series of lessons which focus on linking these with educational and personal requirements for a range of jobs.

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What are the requirements for the 'jobs' I'd be good at and would be interested in?

3. Counselling to ensure that all students are helped to explore a broad range of career options.

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Have I considered all my options?

The Allwell Testing and Careers program assists students and parents in making informed choices about course preferences and realistic career and tertiary study goals. Students may use the program to learn more about possible future pathways and the best way to achieve their goals.

The Allwell Testing date is **Wednesday 9 May 2018** and students will be involved for the whole day. Students and parents/carers will receive a University Admission Centre University Entry Requirements Guide and a personalised report from Allwell Assessment Services before the end of Term Two. This Testing is compulsory for all students and costs \$93 which has been included in your annual school fees.
